


Happy February Folks,



2018 Moose Convention Registration and Housing Now Open

The Moose are headed for the Big Easy! The 2018 International Moose Convention will take place from July 11-15 in New Orleans, Louisiana.

The Convention has not been in New Orleans since 1991, so a strong turnout of members is expected in 2018. Registration and housing are now open at www.moose2018neworleans.org.

New Orleans is known for its food, culture and nightlife, but this year it will also be known for its cutting-edge programming, lively general sessions and an overall festive atmosphere. Moose International has made adjustments to its meetings and programming, offering more interactive workshops, and shorter, keenly-focused general sessions to keep interest at its peak throughout the weekend.

Please note that Moose Convention meetings will be held in three locations: the New Orleans Ernest N. Morial Convention Center, the Sheraton New Orleans (LOOM), and the New Orleans Marriott (WOTM). The other change this year is that meetings will run from Thursday through Sunday, allowing members the opportunity to return to work on Monday, if necessary.

Don't wait to register! Advanced registration and meal function rates are less expensive than on-site rates. Early registration also allows you to plan your trip to take advantage of the sights and sounds of the French Quarter, the historical significance of the National World War II Museum, or even a compelling history and haunts tour. 
