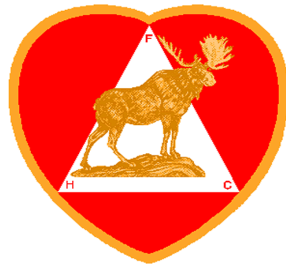

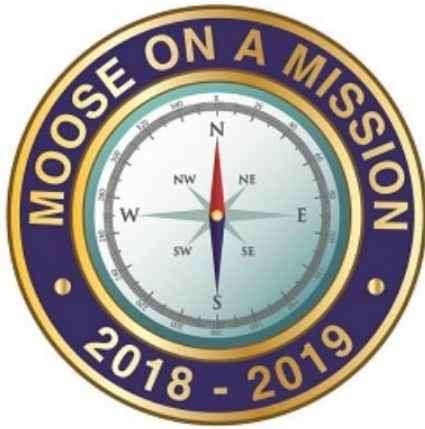

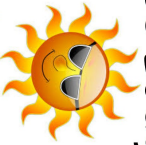
Sign 25 Members Receive free basic registration for our 2019 International Moose Convention in Las Vegas, NV.

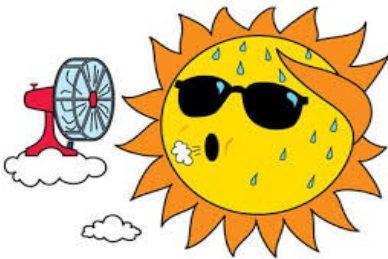
