Hello to all of our Moose Family,

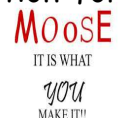

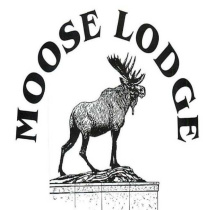


